

Brief History of Hillside Cemetery

In 1822 the cemetery property was deeded to the public by James I Roosevelt. The first burial was that of Mrs. Anna Goodspeed who died on April 16th, 1822.

The cemetery was incorporated during the Civil War and named Hillside Cemetery Association by Mrs. Armonella Devendorf. Mrs Devendorf together with Mrs. G. T. Boynton and Mr. Lewis Fancher solicited funds in 1893 for the original receiving vault. The vault is no longer in use, but still remains in good condition at the cemetery.

Over the century the cemetery grew with the community and its facilities upgraded.

January 1, 2000 the Hillside Cemetery Association deeded the property to the Village of Central Square for perpetual care. The Village Board adopted the name Hillside Memorial Cemetery

Responding to a need for interment options a columbarium was erected in the spring of 2015.

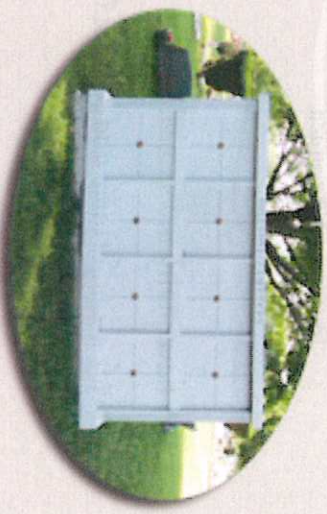

Hillside Memorial Cemetery and Park

Columbarium Policy:

- Nothing shall be placed on top of columbarium or affixed anyplace thereon, including niche doors.
- No individual memorialization or emblem on cemetery owned columbarium or niche.
- Inscription will consist only of name (first, middle initial and last), date of birth (year only) and date of death (year only) and will be done in a uniform, pre-determined font.
- Niche fees shall be paid in full prior to niche assignment.
- Maximum of two sets of remains per niche as space allows.
- No co-mingling of remains is allowed within an urn. Each interment is considered a separate burial.
- No partial niche purchases.
- Interment receptacles, boxes, urns or containers may be of a rustproof metal, such as brass or bronze or of ceramic, or of a non-biodegradable hard plastic. Glass or other easily broken containers are not permitted, nor are containers of
