

## **CHAPTER 6: PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING**

Public input is a critical element of any study. The main goal of the Public Information Meeting was to provide information on the project goals, the existing conditions summary, and preliminary alternatives, as well as to solicit input on the issues, opportunities, and needs within the project area.

Approximately 50 persons attended the Public Information Meeting that was held on Thursday, November 12, 2009 at the Millard Hawk Primary School Auditorium. Following an opening statement by Mayor Murphy, the Consultant Team gave a brief presentation summarizing the work efforts completed to date followed by a question/discussion period. Representatives from the NYSDOT attended the meeting and assisted the Consultant Team with questions regarding the NYSDOT's upcoming design project and its schedule. Much of the discussion with the audience focused on the preliminary alternatives of a modern roundabout within the Village Center and bypass roads around the Village.
